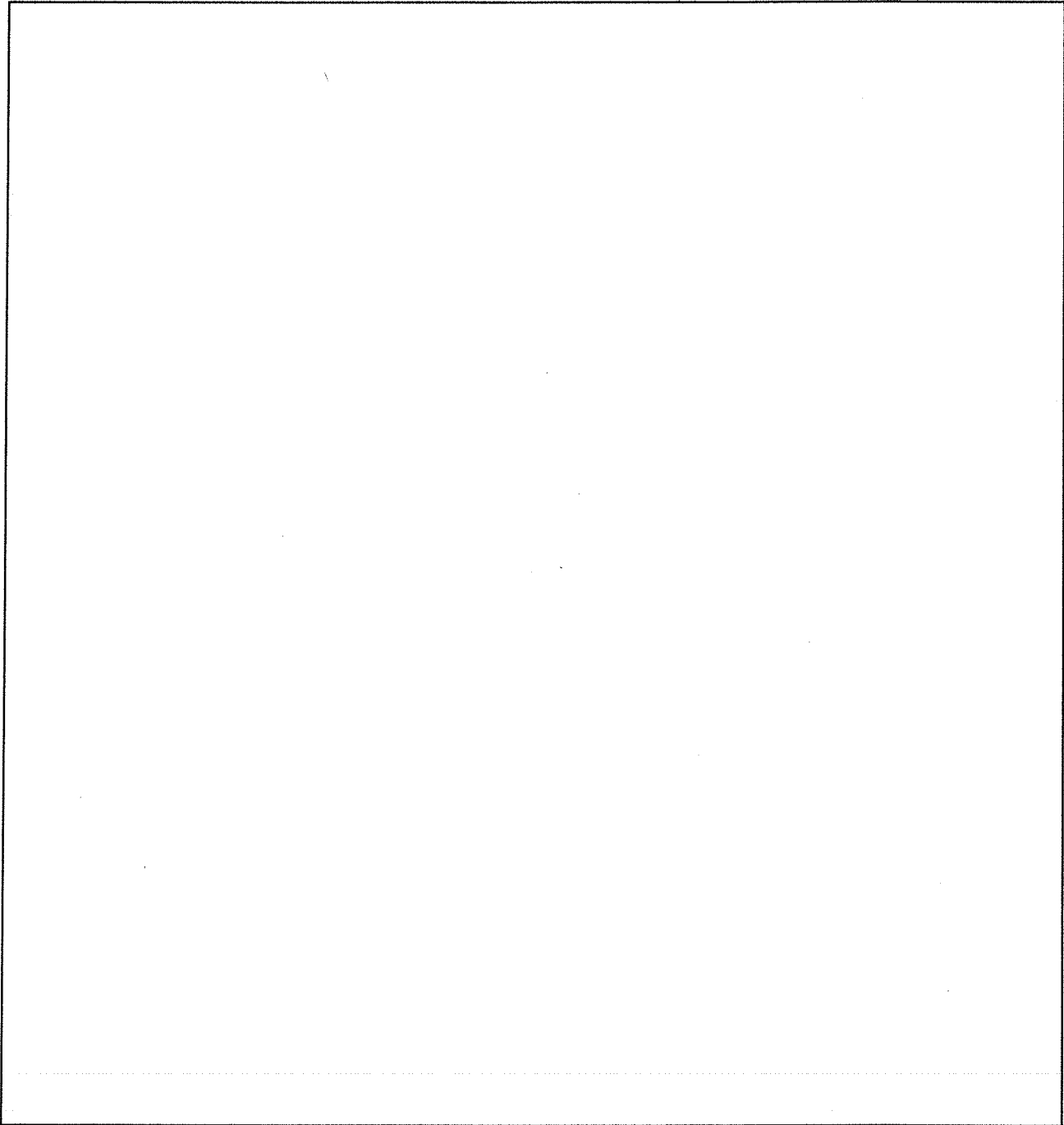

1. Maintain a minimum separation distance of 200 feet from the nearest permanent building, public highway or railroad, or other means of travel.
2. Maintain a minimum separation distance of 50 feet from the nearest above ground telephone pole, tree or other overhead obstruction.
3. Maintain a minimum separation distance of 150 feet from spectators.
4. The area selected for the discharge site, spectator viewing area, parking areas, and the fallout area will be inspected and approved by the permit authority. After the final inspection and approval the sponsor will be issued a *Permit for the Public Display of Fireworks*.
5. No spectators or spectator parking areas will be within the minimum separation distance.
6. Spectators, vehicles, or readily combustible materials will not be within the fallout area down range during the display.
7. The contractor will provide at least two people constantly on duty during the discharge.
8. Fire protection will include at least two approved portable fire extinguishers for the discharge area and standby fire apparatus for protection down range.
9. The contractor will have primary responsibility for safety and prevention of spectators or any other unauthorized persons from entering the discharge site.
10. The contractor will be fully trained in the proper performance of their assigned tasks.
11. The sponsor or contractor shall provide evidence of an indemnity insurance policy with liability coverage an indemnity protection of not less than \$5,000 and conditioned for the payment of all damages which may be caused to a person or persons or to property.
12. Wherever any hazardous condition exists, the sponsor will postpone the fireworks display until the condition is corrected or improves to a reasonable level.
